Jim has met the standards of excellence set by the Professional Photographers of America. He has been awarded the following prestigious degrees:

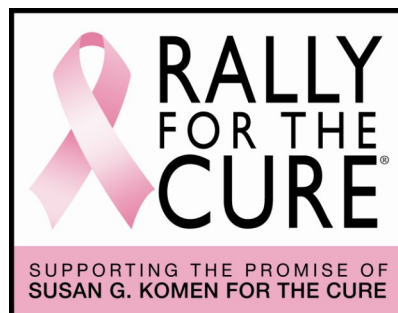
